# RNLI Christmas Shop THURSDAY 10<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER





The end of the year is upon us again and already we are planning for the year to come.

The club will be making a significant change to how we process membership applications, renewals and storage facilities in the coming months as a result of a need to update our club database. Last year we made a move to payment online with STRIPE – this will not change however with our new database you will log into a member's area where you will be able to see and update your personal information such as email, address and contact details.

You will be able to see the car registration numbers that you have provided via the <a href="mailto:sfccparking@gmail.com">sfccparking@gmail.com</a> email account along with your allocated dinghy and engine storage. (Only you will see this information)

I will be moving the annual pontoon berth renewal in line with the club membership renewal which will be done online via email and the secure members area. All dinghy, engine, mooring and pontoon facilities will be payable via the online database. In essence you will get an email to alert you that your annual renewal is due. Logging into the secure members area with your email address you will be able to pay for everything from membership to regalia securely online.

Look out for emails that will come from Starcross Fishing & Cruising Club – they may also have Member Mojo somewhere on them. As we move forward our Membership Sec will advise you of how you can sign into the members area and create a password.

It will be important to remember your membership expires on the 31<sup>st</sup> January each year. The club allows 28 days grace after which if you have not renewed you are deemed to be a lapsed member. All storage, moorings and pontoon berths will return to the club for re allocation on the 28<sup>th</sup> February if you have not renewed your membership, so please pay promptly if you wish to retain your storage facilities.

The process to book any of the storage facilities will not change in that you will need to speak to the Boatswain initially.

A reminder with regards to the clubs parking facilities — <u>if you change your car you need to advise the club by sending an email to sfccparking@gmail.com.</u> This is the only way to advise us so please does not send texts or emails to any other account as they will not be processed. Congratulations go to Mark, Jason and Witold, who gained their **RYA Powerboat Level 2 Certificate** on the last course for this year in early October. If you would like to take the course next year, please email me so that I can place you on the list.

Good luck to all of the members who are embarking on our **Yachtmaster Ocean Theory** course and exam in November. This is the pinnacle of RYA navigational theory training and a rare course to be able to provide. Thank you to club member and RYA Instructor and Trainer Andy Wright, who has made this possible.

I'm hoping to be able to organise **RYA Radar** this winter, for those who wish to take it. The course will take place on the water, using the latest fully functional Radar equipment, rather than in the classroom using a simulator - something very few RYA training centers are able to offer! I have several people who are keen already, if you would like a place on this course, please let me know.

I'm in the process of organising the schedule of RYA courses for next year, which will include: **Essential Navigation and Seamanship**, **Day Skipper Theory** and **Coastal Skipper / Yachtmaster Offshore**Theory, SRC (VHF), First Aid, Diesel Engine Maintenance, Radar as well as RYA Powerboat Level 2 - if you would be interested in taking any of these courses or any other RYA course, please let me know. If we don't run a specific course ourselves, I'm sure to be able to advise you and recommend another RYA center that does.
